The Richter family first purchased vineyards in Brauneberg in 1634 and the family winery is now in its tenth generation of family ownership and management. Richter's 2013s are very good wines—and generally excellent values. (The first three wines have screw cap closures.) The Riesling Classic is a light medium bodied, off dry Mosel Riesling with fresh fruit character (apple, lime), good balance, and medium length.

AP #15. 300 cases. 9.5% The Himmelreich Kabinett is also quite good: light bodied and crisp on the palate, with modest intensity, medium sweetness, and a crisp, lingering finish, tasting of lime, honey, and grapefruit. 4.88% R.S. The Elisenberg Kabinnet is excellent: crisp, medium sweet, and light bodied, with firm acidity, good balance, and long, refreshing finish, tasting of apple, lime, and honeysuckle. 5.51% R.S. AP #23. 450 cases. 8% The Sonnenuhr is an excellent Kabinett feinherb. It is medium bodied, moderately rich in flavor (honey, honeysuckle, peach, pineapple), balanced, and medium long on the finish. 2.33% R.S. AP #07. 200 cases. 10.5% The 'standard' Sonnenuhr Kabinett is equally fine. It is fragrant, light bodied, crisp, finely flavored (apple, lime, honey, grapefruit), and crisp on the palate, with a long finish. 5.47% R.S. AP #18 250 cases. 8% Lastly, the Juffer Kabinett is outstanding: an elegantly flavored, crisp, light bodied wine with a long flavor evolution and a vibrant, persistent finish, tasting of lime, honey, apple, and peach. 5.49% R.S.
