Limpid straw. Incisive citrus pith and succulent herb scents and a hint of chalky minerality. Dry and chewy on the palate, offering bitter lemon and quinine flavors and a touch of fennel on the back half. Closes taut and nervy, displaying good clarity and a subtle floral touch. (JR)
