Generous if not dominant wood fights somewhat with the fresh citrus, floral and mineral reduction scents that once again display enough sulfur to warrant decanting this first. Just like the Vaudésir there is excellent volume and intensity to the powerful big-bodied flavors that deliver outstanding length on the extract-rich finish that really coats the mouth on the hugely long finish. This is going to require ample cellar time if you wish to try it at its peak.
