Domaine Samuel Billaud Chablis Grand Cru "Vaudésir" 2015 Burgundy, France

<u>91 Points</u>

Healthy pale yellow. Pineapple, fresh apricot and smoky oak on the nose. Very rich but salty wine with surprising depth and stony minerality. Showing more soil and stone than fresh fruit today but the wine's mineral energy suggests that it has a bright future. Finishes thick and long, with repeating saline minerality. This struck me as like a larger-scaled version of the Mont de Milieu. (ST)
