

Savennieres Domaine Laffourcade

The 2010 Savennières from Domaine Laffourcade is really very nicely low octane in personality, coming in at a cool twelve percent in alcohol. The wine offers up a very pretty nose of apple, quince, lanolin, a nice dollop of soil, a bit of youthful Chenin dustiness and a touch of paraffin in the upper register. On the palate the wine is fullish, deep and complex, with a fine core, fairly soft acids for the vintage, a lovely signature of soil and impressive length and grip on the finish. This is still quite youthful in terms of its complexity, but with these low acids, I would suspect that drinking this on the early side is the best course. It is certainly long, focused and offers up lovely flavors and aromatics for near-term drinking, but it lacks the cut to age for more than a few years.
