Irancy “Mazelots” 2013

The 2013 Irancy Les Mazelots has a tightly wound bouquet with dark plum and wild strawberry scents, just a little more withdrawn than the 2012 at the moment. The palate is fresh and sappy on the entry with plenty of well-defined, vivacious dark plum and blackberry fruit segueing into a lightly spiced finish. I find a little more complexity here compared to the 2012 at the moment. This is a fine, well-crafted Irancy.
