Samuel Billaud Chablis 1er Cru "Les Fourneaux" 2013 Burgundy, France

Score: 90

Pale yellow. Very reticent nose hints at lemon zest and crushed rock. Rich, creamy and concentrated, with citrus and white truffle flavors firmed on the end by an austere chalky quality. More serious than exotic. Made from organically farmed vines that yielded just 35 hectoliters per hectare in 2013. – ST
