Light red color. This is an outstanding example of Chavignol rosé with orange citrus and cherry skin scents. It's full in the mouth with a perfumed palate of raspberry, rhubarb and lingering notes of melon. Great acidity and freshness. Made from 35 year old, organically cultivated Pinot Noir vines grown in the domaine's 6 ha vineyard in Chavignol.
