This is more obviously exotic in character with its nose of orange peel, spice, floral, apricot and discreet iodine nuances that are trimmed in just enough wood to warrant mentioning. The palate impression of the middle weight flavors is also impressively voluminous and rich though not so much that it's ponderous, all wrapped in a lingering and reasonably well-balanced finale. Good stuff that should also drink well early on yet reward mid-term cellaring too.
