Domaine de la Pousse d'Or Chambolle-Musigny Les Charmes 1er Cru 2014 Burgundy, France

90 Points

Red-ruby; moderately saturated in the context of this set of 2014s. The nose offers a very ripe blackberry liqueur quality but comes across as less expressive than the Volnays at this address. Quite imploded on the palate, with its firm minerality contributing to an impression of medicinal reserve. The wine's brisk acidity and lightly herbal character suggest an element of inconsistent ripeness but the tannins are essentially supple and the finish is chewy and persistent. (ST)
