A slightly more complex and deeply pitched nose speaks of more evident floral elements, and in particular violet, that add a touch of elegance to the poached plum and dark cherry scents. On the palate the attractively textured medium weight flavors possess a beguiling mouth feel, once again primarily thanks to the firm if fine-grained tannins, all wrapped in a dusty and ever-so-mildly youthfully austere finale. In the same fashion as the Fashauer, this is going to require at least a few years of cellaring first. **Outstanding**
