This silken red captures the sun on a stony hillside, an acre of land on an east-facing slope where the oldest vines date to 1956. Its flavors brighten toward red cherries and the fresh, herbal sweetness of cherry tomatoes in mid-summer, underlain with crisp, mineral-inflected tannins that frame the wine along with its oak. For all their power, those tannins end softly, firm yet gracious. A Corton that lives up to its grand cru status.
