Chablis 1er Cru "Mont de Milieu" 2014 Burgundy, France

The 2014 Chablis 1er Cru Mont de Milieu, of which 5% is matured in barrel and the remainder in stainless steel vat, has a crisp orange blossom scented bouquet with hints of granite underneath. But this is a pretty and feminine bouquet. The palate is crisp and pure with just a faint touch of lychee complemented by white peach and Conference pear, tapering in a little towards a strict and slightly resinous, but compelling finish. This appears to have built on its promise from last year and deserves a higher score. - NM
